

**POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**  
**Tenure Track Faculty Position – Broiler Nutrition**

The Department of Poultry Science at Auburn University is seeking candidates for the position of Assistant/Associate/Full Professor in broiler nutrition. This position will directly serve the largest agricultural commodity, the commercial broiler industry, in the State of Alabama. The expected start date for this position is August 16, 2008. Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.

**Responsibilities:** This is a 9-month tenure track position (20% instruction, 80% research). The 9-month salary may be supplemented through research grants and opportunities for summer teaching. The successful candidate will be responsible for the development of an independent and nationally recognized research program in broiler nutrition, with particular emphasis on commercial broiler production. The research program should include both applied and basic efforts. Teaching responsibilities will include instruction of undergraduate courses and advising undergraduate students. Participation in the departmental graduate program is also expected. Research and teaching activities will result in publication of refereed articles in journals and other appropriate outlets, such as books, technical bulletins and conference papers. Collaboration with other scientists in the department, college and other institutions, as appropriate, will be expected. Service to the department, college, university and profession are also expected.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Minimum qualifications include an earned PhD in poultry nutrition, animal nutrition or a closely related field by the position start date. Candidates must have documented experience and/or evidence of the ability to function as a successful teacher at the undergraduate level. In addition, candidates must have the qualifications, experience and enthusiasm to develop a nationally-recognized research program in broiler nutrition. Candidates must have developed a successful publication record commensurate with their experience; display excellent interpersonal skills to effectively interact with diverse audiences and must demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively in English. The candidate selected for the position must be able to meet eligibility requirements for work in the United States at the time appointment is scheduled to begin and continue working legally for the proposed term of employment.

**Application:** Salary commensurate with qualifications and experience. Applicants must submit a letter of application summarizing your qualifications for this position, curriculum vitae, copies of all transcripts, and the names, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses of three references to:
